1. If people are planning on abusing children, they're not going to announce their bad intentions.

2. If people don't announce intentions of abusing children, then licensing parents to prevent against willful mistreatment offers no new protection to abused children from people who we don't yet know are abusing.

4. There are already systems in place to help children from abusive homes.

5. Whenever there is a system in place to help children from abusive homes, licensing parents won't provide any new protection from people who we do know are abusing.
