Reading Questions for April 19

These questions cover excerpts from a book written by Douglas Husak and Peter de Marneffe called *The Legalization of Drugs*. The answers do not have to be turned in. You will probably have to read more than once to get the answers.

Background:

We are spending this week talking about the legal drinking age. We started Monday by looking at some general theoretical issues surrounding the legalization of drugs; today we'll start focusing in on alcohol. We'll also spend a little bit talking about a couple of other drugs, including marijuana. Then on Friday we'll focus in on the drinking age in particular.

Questions:

- 1. On pages 171-4, de Marneffe lays out some harms that would be reduced by making alcohol illegal. What are these harms? Do you agree with him about the harms? Why?
- 2. On pages 174-7, de Marneffe discusses whether there are any reasons to think that policies of heroin and alcohol prohibition are equally defensible. What does he say? Do you agree with him? Why?
- 3. From pages 177-85, de Marneffe discusses the prohibition of several other drugs, including marijuana, cocaine, and LSD. What does he say? Do you agree with him? Why?
