

Rough Draft

Instructions: you should print this assignment out and bring it to class on **April 14th**. (If you can't bring it to class, you should email it to me; my email address is immerman@ksu.edu. If you email it in, it won't count as turned in unless I send an email confirming I've received it.) This assignment should be at least 800 words long. I like to grade as anonymously as possible, so please **do not put your name on the top of the paper, but instead put it on the opposite side of the page or on a second page**. If you have any questions about how to complete the assignment, please let me know.

- The goal of this assignment is to write a draft of your final paper. If you haven't looked at the final paper assignment sheet, you should definitely check it out before completing this assignment.

Note: you will be discussing these rough drafts in class with your peers. Writing this rough draft and discussing it in class will be most helpful for you if you have spent some time thinking about what you will say in your paper. If you just write it quickly, and your paper ends up being substantially different, then discussing it won't be as helpful.

Late policy: I will accept this assignment late, but take off 10 percent off for every day it's late.

I'll grade this assignment pass/fail/didn't turn in and it's worth 2 percent of your grade. Pass is equivalent to a 95 (A) – if you do a super-awesome job, I'll give you some bonus points. Participating in the in-class discussion of these, which will be on April 24th and 26th, will be worth an additional 4 percent of your grade. (There will be a make-up activity if you can't attend those days.)
